AS WAREHOUSE OPERATOR AND WAREHOUSE LOGISTICS SPECIALIST

Do you prefer to be well organised rather than having to go looking for things? Then your kind of perspective makes you just right for SOVEREIGN.

We're seeking people with great organisational skills, who, as warehouse clerks, are responsible for the acceptance of goods and checking the quantity and condition of deliveries using the accompanying documentation. As a warehouse operator, you will use our scanners to register goods and enter their data into our IT system. You must comply with various regulations and provisions for customs, dangerous goods and airfreight shipments when stocking and taking goods out of the warehouse, of which you will be advised during your training.

In addition, you will regularly monitor stock levels and carry out inventories. Your duties will also include the packaging and commissioning of goods.

You will also load and unload lorries using forklift trucks and hand over goods upon inspection of their documents.

The training is two years in duration. Upon successfully passing of the exam, it is possible to complete further training as a warehouse logistics specialist. During this further training, you will also learn how to plan, organise and monitor the use of work equipment and funds. You will also be responsible for the overall stock control and will therefore be involved with quality assurance measures. You will gain a feeling for the spatial organisation of goods.

Furthermore, you will examine the existing storage and transportation processes and design these more efficiently. This will allow you to carry out active improvements within the company.
