AS A PROFESSIONAL DRIVER

Do you enjoy plenty of travel and are you a night-time person who relishes the unexpected? Then explore these possibilities together with SOVEREIGN Europe while completing an apprenticeship.

You will complete your training within SOVEREIGN'S extensive European overnight route network in alternation with visits to the training school. And don't worry – you will get your HGV licence with us as part of your training, so you don't already need one in advance.

As a professional driver you will transport valuable goods to arrive safely and on schedule at their destinations and are therefore one of the key members of the SOVEREIGN network. You will be given a large amount of responsibility from the start.

You will learn from your colleagues how to deal with dangerous situations and also how to load goods safely. In order that you also develop an understanding of the vehicles from a technical perspective, you will be given an insight into the activities of the commercial vehicle mechatronics engineers at our subsidiary company, ACTIV CARS, near Bremen.

Even if you aren't training for an office job, you will be expected to do some administrative work, for example, the recording of jobs and travel times.
